Composing for film, TV, concert hall, and theater, he is also the Music Assistant to Oscar®-winning composer Alan Menken and has worked on the recent live-action THE LITTLE MERMAID, BEAUTY AND THE BEAST, and ALADDIN films.

Aaron's film work has been featured at film festivals around the world, including Cannes, Tribeca, Montreal, Zurich, St. Kilda, Austin, and many more.

Aaron was awarded Australian Young Composer of the Year, as well winning a Telly Award for Best Music/Jingle for ETIHAD. He was also nominated for Best Song at the Hollywood in Media Awards. His feature film scores include the Australian psychological thriller CRUSHED, Indigenous documentary REMAKING THE PATHWAY, as well as a live concert performance of the Buster Keaton classic SEVEN CHANCES.

He has also written music for several advertising campaigns, including Gucci, Samsung, and Honda.
